Site Visit at Klong Kern sub-district, Meuang, Samutsongkhram 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2013

### Problem



Klong Kern sub-district in Samutsongkhram province is one community that genuinely shares a common negative impact caused by the over-ruled industrialization which are insufficient agriculture labor resource that move to industrial sector, in harmony with the fading of indigenous knowledge on agriculture.

The usage of chemical fertilizer and pesticide were encouraged by the industrialization. The revolution brings about health issue, debt caused by high cost of inventory and gradually-becomedistant social relationship especially in family.



## **Community Operation**

Dr. Usa Tienthong

In 1999, Provincial Community inspired by Dr. Usa Tienthong, a chairman of Sub-district Community Organization, to print her foot step on public service state. She involved local residents in Klong Kern sub-district on identifying situation, and together, discovered the importance of community cooperation. In collaboration with Sub-district headmen, Village headmen, members of Sub-district Administrative Organization and other organizations, they carried out Co-Community Model Scheme and transform Klong Kern sub-district into strong collaborative and learning community. They established House of Sub-district Community Organization in 2008 which nowadays has "mobile conference" to villages on 19th of each month. From Co-Community Model Scheme to Sub-district Community Organization, this community has been developed the groups which are organized follow the Philosophy of the "Sufficiency Economy" (a philosophy bestowed by His Majesty the King), as follows




# 1. community enterprise of organic coconut sugar




### 4. Group of dessert product
